“Export forum to Arab Countries ” Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico.

On October 10 had been place in Guadalajara, Jalisco the Export forum to Arab Countries made by The Arab Mexican Chamber of Industry and Commerce (CAMIC) and the Institute of Foreign Commerce of State of Jalisco (JALTRADE).

Mr. Ruben Reséndiz Pérez, General Manager of the Institute of Foreign Commerce of State of Jalisco (JALTRADE) gave the welcome message to this forum, thanking CAMIC for their assistances as a main expositor for this forum, remarked the importance of this region; due to in the last years the Arab Countries has become in an out standing region important and in constant growth.

After that Eng. Joaquín Pría Olavarrieta, President of the Arab Mexican Chamber of Industry and Commerce thanked for the invitation to this forum and remarked the importance to have presence of Mexican productos in other regions of the world. Added that the Arab Countries have to be a markets of interest for diversification of Mexico, due to the importance and economic growth on the region and the increase of population and the increase of the necessities of the population. Who has become to region in one of the zones more dynamic for foreign trade and open a new opportunities for Mexican companies in different sectors for exports.

Eng. Pría remarked that due to exist different challenges for companies who wants to get into the Arab Market, there existe many other opportunities in the region and Mexican businessmen have to be prepared for diversification facing a challenging international scenario with big changes.

Remarked that the main objective of CAMIC, since 20 years ago has shown to Mexican companies different opportunities who Arab Countries has to offer for their products. Also, the Chamber has been on charge to promote the commercial relation with this countries and through promotion and cooperation regarding business opportunities and given personalized services for the necessities of each company.

On the panel of Business Opportunities for Arab Countries, Mrs. Martha Lopez Acle, Promotion Manager of CAMIC, detailed that the Arab Countries have a population of 400.96 million of habitants, a PIB of \$3, 020, 411 billion dollars and an economic increase of 4.63% average rate which becomes to the region in one of the most dynamic in the world. Also to have economies and population who increase in stable terms and have rich energetic resources and a touristic attractive and a youth population interested in innovating productions. Who had become to the region in one zone of big opportunities for international trade.

Mrs. López remarked, that now a days Mexico export to United Arab, Emirates, Argel, Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, Egypt and Morocco, where the main export products are: industrial machinery, medical equipment, casing tubes, vehicles, cellphones. refrigerators, vaccines, honey, oat, avocado, chickpeas, candies and sauces. Added that exist many potential sectors for Mexican companies who are: electrical industrial, agro alimentary, chemistry, cosmetic, luxury goods, construction materials, auto parts and renewal energies.

Emphasizing that this are only some main products who's has been exported, but there are not the only ones with potential. And its important research on and individual way each product to identify potential on the region.

Another topic who has spoked inside this season, were trade barriers, custom and no custom barriers which main objective of Mexican companies known more about the topics that focus on before to export to Arab Market. Also has been remarked that the exportation to Arab Market. Inside this forum detailed that the companies has to focus on the promotion into Arab Countries and main commercialization channels and distribution.

After that has been presented the successful cases, in which, two Mexican companies affiliates to the Chamber, shared their experience and the incursion into Arab Markets and the challenges who means for their enterprises, this with main objective to explain to that assistance had a realistic vision of this subject.



The first intervention on this panel, was made by Mr. Aldo Velázquez Ramírez, Business Director of Best Ground, company dedicated to produce natural and organic products as sugars, comestible oils, grains etc. Who commented that the companies decides to focus their sells on United Arab Emirates due to this is one of the countries who has better access on the region and in the last years has become in a hub to reexport to many other countries on the region. This gave them the opportunity to establish a Mexican distribution warehouse on the Free Zone of Dubai.

Also, Mr. Velazquez made emphasis in fourth recommendations who has to take into consideration the Mexican Companies who wants to get into the Arab Market, there are: take into the consideration the product, price, distribution, planning, remarked also the importance of patients to do business, with this market. All this with the objetive to have very clear the final consumer, the value added which you can have with this products to have a competitive price on the region and be very careful with the proceses, the investment and the expenses and time.

Second intervention was made for Mr. Fernando Tejeda, Commercial Director of Latex Occidental, company dedicated to ballon manufactory which now a days has an office of representation in Siria and Saudi Araba. Who remarked, that the process to get into the Arab Market, wasn't so easy for them, who implied time due to they have into consideration local problems and made many visits to the region. However, they say that the Arab Market has big gains if they can develop a long time relation with the clients in the region.

Mr. Tejeda advice to the assistance, get into consideration cultural differences, mainly for products like them who depends of seasoning and festivities, visiting the region to known the market and the clients; visiting trade fairs of sector to have a very close relations with the final costumer to known the preference of market to known the difference of the market and search common aspects of cultural level who can joint with a client.

Inside of the Alternative for logistics of exportation and distribution panel, Mrs. Gabriela Altuzar, Special Operations Manager of Talik Logistics Mexico, detailed basic topics who has to get into consideration a Mexican company to export, remarking the strategic planning, knowing of product and all the document and packing who are required to exportation country.

Made emphasis that the Mexican companies has to have very clear their costs of production, packing, storage, taxes, insurance, rate exchange and fiscal expenses to have very clear the final price of the product.

Also have been mentioned, transportation time between the main ports of Mexico to Arab Countries, with the main objective of Mexican Companies can sight transportation into the business negotiations.



Free Economic Zones in Mexico without fees

The companies who has a business at Free Economic Zones will have a profits of 100 per cent at income tax on the first 10 years and zero per cent of value-added tax on the purchasing of national goods.

On June 22 -when the Inter sectorial committee of Free Economic Zones approved viability of establishment of operations of this zones. On September 29 some ideas, lists and theories expressed about this zone located in Laza Cárdenas, Coatzacoalcos and Puerto Chiapas.

One of the profits is a discount of 100 per cent on the first ten fiscal exercises of income taxes (ISR) to the companies who establish inside of Free Economic Zone. In the next five fiscal exercises the discount will be of 50 per cent. In a few words: the companies will not pay the income taxes through ten years and just 50 percent in the next five years.

Second profit: when a company established on the Free Economic Zone and buy national goods they will apply a rate of zero per cent of Value-added tax.

At this point exists two profits. There's no value added tax and the transactions realized and joint inside the same Free Economic Zone.

Third profit, this is to who wants to train works inside of the Free Economic Zone, who will apply for a fiscal incentive of 25 per cent of their spend for train employees.

Fourth profit includes a fiscal credit of contribution for who they also count with a business inside of Free Economic Zones.

Fifth profit, for those who bought a propriety inside of the Free Economic Zone, will be free of the corresponding fees.

IMF forecast a better increase in Mexico in this year; GDP will be of 2.1%

The International Monetary Found increase their forecast for Mexican Economy. Inside of the World Economic Outlook (WEO), the FMI estimates that the Mexican Economy will grow in 2.1 per cent this year, from 1.9 per cent updated in July.

The outlook in the increase of GDP reports and increase in the trust of the market, despite of uncertainly related with the renegotiation of North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA), who reads at the document.

The new aim of found it was located in the low expectations of Finance Ministry for this year, who is between 2 y 2.6 per cent.

For the next year, the IMF forecast that Mexican economy will expand in 1.9 per cent with a correction at the low respect with the previous of 2.1 per cent.

This expectation its under the estimated of growing that the Mexican government saids, who is between 2 and 3 per cent.

This forecast consigned an impact that will have the economic development in the United States in Mexican path.

On the analysis made by the found, remarked that “as the concern has decrease regarding trade frictions with United States, Mexican peso has depreciate in 10 per cent, showing a concern in the recovery of the trust in financial markets.

For United States, the IMF expects an expansion of 2.2 per cent in 2017 and 2.3 per cent for 2018, which has incorporated a review in the increase regarding of data in July, when they expect an expansion of 2.1 in both cases.

At the advanced economies, the organization hopes that in the Eurozone registered an increase of 2.1 this year from the 1.9 per cent forecasted for 2018 and estimated a GDP of 1.9 per cent.

Meat production in Mexico reach a record amount

Meat production in Mexico reach historical production in 6.5 million tons in 2016, which means an increase of 202 thousand of tons and represented 332 per cent more that the obtain on the last year.

Ministry of the Secretariat of Agriculture, livestock, rural development, fisheries and food (SAGARPA) informed that thanks to the politics and improvement of the productivity, which has been boost by federal government, there are made some important improvements and production of pork meat 4.0 per cent.

At the same time, poultry (3.8 per cent), meanwhile egg production and milk had a positive development of 2.5 per cent and 1.9 per cent. In this case, right policies applied by the government and the efforts of the

producers made that from January to June 2017, production of meat was a superior way in 2.8 per cent regarding to the same time of 2016.

Explain that in the first six semesters of this year, the generation of pork, poultry productos increase 4.2, 2.3 and 2.4 per cent.

Automotive export and production increased in September

In September, the Mexican market produced 307,174 vehicles representing 7.7% growth, compared to September 2016, according to the Mexico Automotive Industry Association (Asociación Mexicana de la Industria Automotriz abbreviated AMIA).

Manufacturers with the highest production growth rate were Volkswagen (180.5%) due to the Tiguan production in Puebla, followed by KIA (43.6%) and Fiat Chrysler (30.9%).

Regarding exports, 270, 899 units were shipped abroad representing 15% increase compared to September 2016.

Automotive exports to the United States increased 7.8%, to Canada 9.2% and to Asia 133%.

Exports to Europe stand out since the export increased 310%. Particularly exports to Germany increased 3.4% to Italy 0.8% and to France 0.5%.

Manufacturers with the highest export growth were Volkswagen (72.4%), Mazda (60.3%) and Nissan (38.1%) while Ford reported 46.2% production decrease and 31.7% export decrease during September.

Queretaro will invest around 60 million dollar pesos.

Through the time July 2016 and July 2017 the state of Queretaro reported nine projects approved on investment and development, in an amount around 60.4 million pesos, according with SEDASU. Which generates around 709 employees.

According with the results of federal government on the second year of actual administration also they took many actions to connect between academic sector and private initiative and the governmental authorities, which is recognized as triple propeller.

This, together with an strategic of straighten of activities of company clusters in the state. In this sense, Sedasu informed that will supported projects focused on diagnostic of necessities and mapping on capacities if clusters of automotive sector, aeronautic and plastics, which were allow benefit in more that 65 enterprises in process of productive integration.

Which will be benefice directly 13 companies of aerospace on the entity, on the realization of a integral project to strengthen of competitiveness of the companies in this sector, same that allowed develop to technical capacities and obtain other certifications needed to achieve the required standards to be considered industry providers.

this support its also on medical cluster, with an a professionalization to increase competitiveness of the companies in medical sector and health sector, who permits improve their process on administration and planning, control, and accounting, in an effect who could offer a services in best quality on the users.

Industrial production increases 0.3% in August.

In August, the dynamism of manufacturing and construction increased Mexico's industrial production, according to the National Institute of Statistics and Geography (Instituto Nacional de Estadística y Geografía abbreviated Inegi).

Mining production, electricity production, transmission, and distribution, piped water and gas supply construction, and manufacturing increased 0.3% during August 2017, The highest rate since December 2015.

On an individual bases, the manufacturing industries increased 0.5% and the construction sector increased 0.3% while mining decreased 2.3% and electricity production, transmission, and distribution, along with water and gas supply by pipeline fell 0.5% compared to the previous month.

It should be noted that half of manufacturing activities reported a monthly increase in August such as basic metal industries (9.3%) and petroleum and coal productions (8.4%) compared with the previous month.

However, in an annual comparison, Mexico's industrial production presented 0.6% decrease in August.

On an individual basis, mining (9.6%) construction (-1.5). and electricity production, transmission, and distribution, along with water and gas supply by pipeline (-0.5%) while manufacturing increased 3.1 compared to august 2016.

First Investments at Special Economic Zones will be ready on February 2018.

In February 2018 will be ready the first investments on the three Special Economic Zones already detected declared Maz Margenthaler Canseco, head of Promotion of Investments in the Federal Authority for Develop the Special Economic Zones.

Till today there are intentions to invest 6.500 billion of dollars for this five Economic Zones in development, three zones a decorated in Puerto Chiapas, Coatzacoalcos y Lazaro Cárdenas and both that will be officialized by the president in Salina Cruz, Oaxaca and Progreso Yucatán. declared Margenthaler.

At the meeting with media, the head of AFDZEE explain that there are 152 prospected enterprises with interest to establish in some part of this zones, with 126 negotiations are advanced, and from this, 50 have been wrote their interest in a letter of intentions.

There are two the steps to the money arrives in this zones, one for the land that will be private and other for federal zone.

In the part that will be private the AFDZEE will emite their laws to give permissions. Has maximum 50 days since the declaratory made on September 28.

Once published our laws, the companies can start with the process to execute their investment and ill be wait that the permissions will be expedid at immediate form and in January or February have there the money, said Mergenthaler.

Regarding a federal land, will have to wait for the allocation of the winner as Integral Administrator in the next six months and after two months will be in the investments.

We estimate that in June 2018 the investment ill be materialized on the first federal lands on the three first Special Economic Zones, declared.

Regarding generation of employment on the three zones it ill be apron 12 thousand direct sources of employment and between 2 or 4 thousands in Oaxaca and Yucatan.

Sectors more attracted to establish operations are metal mechanic, iron and manufacturing in Puerto Chiapas, and Coatzacoalcos are petrochemical, chemical, energy and agro industries and in Lazaro Cárdenas there are steel and cultivate tuna, energy and automotive.


The head of Unit of Promotion and Investment declared there are two groups of interest for legal administration.

Aerospace sector in the State of Queretaro its value in 70 MDD

The Secretariat of Development Sustainable of Queretaro, reported a considerable amount in aeroespacial around 60 and 70 million dollars declared the Ministry, Marco Antonio del Prete Tercero.

Interviewed at the end of the inauguration of the First International Aeronautical conference, said that throughout the last two years have been concremented 10 projects of investment in this industry, with a total amount of 953 million pesos, who have been generate 1.073 thousands of employees.

The investments are mainly from Europe and United States, declared. The Ministry declared that in the projects are waiting to be concremented, are the seventh plant of the Safran Company, and many other proposal that are in analysis.

We are knocking doors with good results, and Queretaro continue establishing as a hub from investment projects of aeroespacial sector.

At the same time the secretariat of SEDATU remarked that The Azteca 1 project from the company Horizontex, which has been worked

on development of the first “Mexican plane”. This initiative of the plane made fully in Mexico were made by National Center of Aeronautic Technologies (CENTA).


In recent days, the prototype of this plane made his first testing fly from Queretaro, which has been made by CENTA and will be the bases for many other SME’s enterprises on aeronautical industries which can developed.







Increase the value of the manufactory production on the center of Mexico

From January to August 2017 the value of the manufacture industry in the center of the country increase at the 15.4 annual per cent, according with information of National Institute of Statistics and Geography (INEGI).

Results of the monthly study of the manufactory industry which is elaborate by this Institute said that the advance in the state of San Luis Potosí who registered an increase of 24.5 per cent in 2016 an amount of 197,933 million of pesos, followed by Aguascalientes, which has an increase of 14.4 per cent, with a value of 155,893 million pesos.

Guanajuato reported a value of production at the manufactories of 476,945 million pesos on the first eight months of the year, which means an increase of 13.6 per cent regarding the same time of the last year, in Querétaro was an increase of 9.3 annual percent with 177, 178 billion pesos.

At national level, the increase of the production of manufactory industry has an annual increase of 14 percent in January to August 2017, registered an amount of 4 billions of pesos according to INEGI.

The manufacture sector in the center of Mexico has been strengthen due to the boost in the sectors like automotive equipment, agro industry, and equipment of equity and manufactory production.

In the case of made and manufactory of transport equipment which represent the half of value of the manufactory production in the Zone, Guanajuato reported a value of 251 billion of pesos in the first eight months of 2017.




